Area Legislators Receive Key Appointments

RALEIGH—Southeastern NC Representatives received key chairmanship appointments in the General Assembly. Speaker of the N.C. House, Rep. Tim Moore, announced standing committee chairs. New Hanover County Representative Ted Davis Jr. was named Chairman of Judiciary 1 and Chair of Appropriations Subcommittee on Justice and Public Safety. Pender County Representative Chris Millis was named Chairman of Regulatory Reform. Brunswick County Representative Frank Iler was named a Chairman of the Transportation and Appropriations Subcommittee.

Representative Ted Davis said, “I am very excited about the 2017-2018 biennium. I have advanced to seat #27 in the House Chamber and I am moving into a larger office. My new Committee assignments are Judiciary 1(Chair); Appropriations (Vice Chair); Appropriations Justice and Public Safety (Chair); Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the

House (Vice Chair); Commerce and Job Development; Elections and Ethics Law; and Education-Universities. I look forward to having the privilege of continuing to represent District 19 and working on behalf of the remainder of New Hanover County.”

Speaker Moore commented, “I have the highest confidence that each chair will work successfully with their committee members to fix complex policy problems, pass historic reforms and find solutions for the most important issues in our state.”

NC Senate Pro Tempore Phil Berger appointed Senator Michael Lee to be a Chairman on the Education Committee for the 2017-2018 biennium.

“The North Carolina Senate is fortunate to have members committed to good government with a focus on reducing the tax burden on working families, improving our state’s business climate and strengthening public education,” said Berger.

Senator Michael Lee said, “I am excited about the opportunity to chair both the Education Policy and Education Appropriations Committees in the NC Senate. Those two appointments, along with my membership in a variety of other committees will allow me to continue making an impact for the citizens of our community and state.”
